In 1913 Balfour reported *Bos indicus* cattle in the Koalib area of Sudan which he claimed were immune to trypanosomiasis (Balfour, 1913). Since that date trypanotolerance has been reported in other *Bos indicus* breeds in Sudan, Zaire, Uganda and Kenya (see Dolan, 1987 for references).
