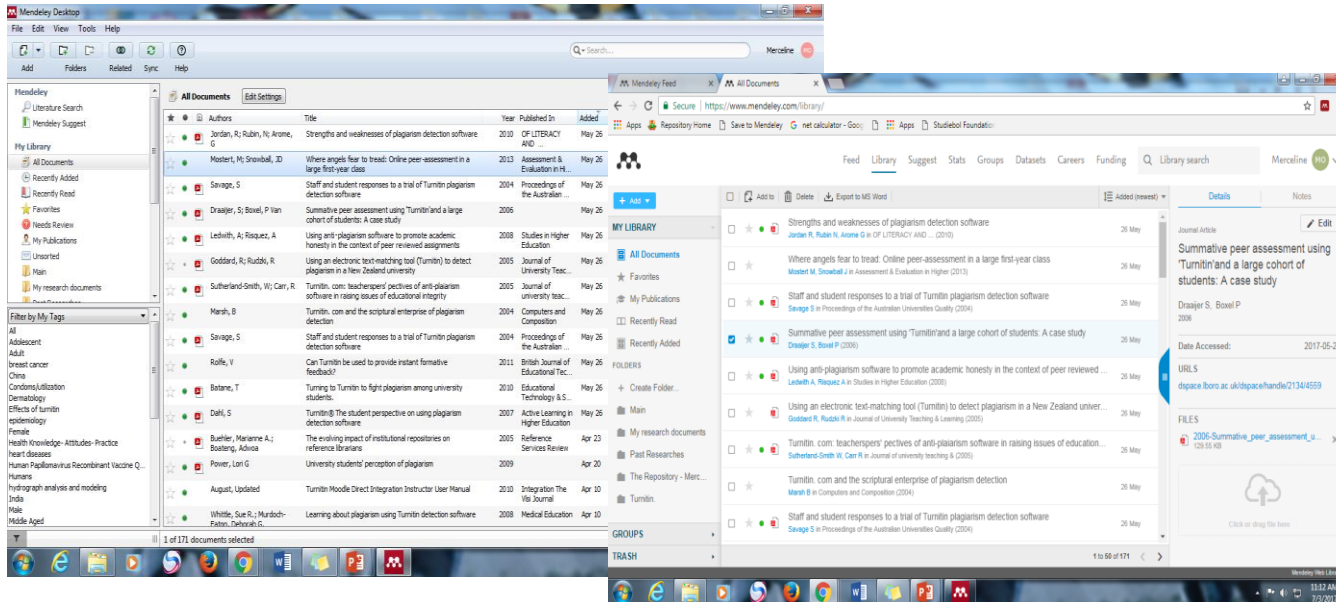

What's Mendeley

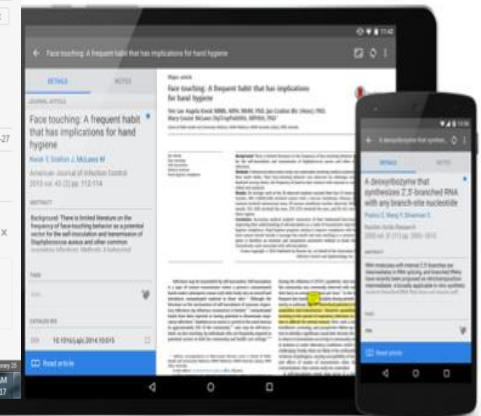
- A Free Academic Software
- Is a reference management software and academic social network that help one:
 - ❖ Organize research by managing citation and documents
 - ❖ Collaborate with other researchers
 - ❖ Discover latest research in an area of interest .
- Available both online and offline versions
 - ❖ Mendeley Desktop is the offline version, downloaded and installed in the computer.
 - ❖ Mendeley Web is online where you can access the web version of your library, edit your profile and search for papers, groups or people.




